

CLASSES OF NOXIOUS WEEDS

NOTE - Classes 1, 2 and 5 are notifiable weeds – an occupier must notify the LCA within 24 hours, a public authority must notify the LCA within 3 days. For any notifiable weed a permit must be obtained if moving or transporting it.

Class 1

Control measures

The plant must be eradicated from the land and the land must be kept free of the weed.
