Fireweed	<i>Senecio madascariensis</i>	Bega Valley Shire
Nodding thistle	<i>Carduus nutans</i>	Bega Valley Shire
Pampas grass	<i>Cortaderia</i> ssp.	Bega Valley Shire
Paterson's curse/Viper's bugloss/Italian bugloss	<i>Echium</i> ssp.	Bega Valley Shire
Perennial ragweed	<i>Ambrosia psilostachya</i>	Bega Valley Shire
