IMPORTANT DISPOSAL INFORMATION

Management of Asbestos Cement Sheeting

Asbestos is only accepted at Council's Pambula Asbestos Landfill by appointment.

The following safety guidelines must be followed:

- Thoroughly wet each sheet of asbestos;
- Wrap asbestos waste in heavy-duty builders' plastic (the grade of plastic must be at least 200 microns thick);
- Completely seal the package, using builders' tape or duct tape. Packages must be wrapped in manageable sizes for hand unloading;
- Waste must be carefully unloaded by hand to prevent the release of dust.

Asbestos must never be transported dry or unwrapped. It must not be unloaded by a tipping vehicle. If you do not follow these directions we may prosecute you under the *Local Government Act (1993)*.

Asbestos cement sheeting greater than 200m² or any amount of friable asbestos must be managed by a licensed contractor under Work Cover NSW guidelines. When a contractor is used their license number must be included on this form.
