**IMPORTANT INFORMATION**You **MUST** supply Council with a copy (hard copy or electronic) of photos of the overgrown property. If you do not supply photos, Council may not act on your request.

Council can only request that a property be cleared/mowed when the property is in an unsafe or unhealthy condition.

**In the first instance the neighbour should make contact with the owner.**

When requesting owners to clear/mow their property, Council must follow the process below. If Council fails to follow the process, it MAY mean that we will not be successful in our request to have the property cleared/mowed.

This process can take **up to 4 months or more** before a final outcome is achieved and the property is successfully cleared or mowed.
