## New fence at Candelo Sportsground



The heart of Candelo has a new look and is ready for the busy, warmer months ahead.

Council's maintenance team have just installed a new fence at the Candelo Sportsground, along its boundary with William Street.

The old white timber fence that was so much a part of the town was rotting and has been replaced with a similar looking structure made of white powder coated metal.

### Draft Merimbula and Back Lake Flood Study exhibition

Council and our consultant, Cardno, are progressing with the flood study for the Merimbula Lake and Back Lake catchments.

The project has now reached the end of Stage 3 for flood modelling and the draft findings are now on public exhibition.

The study will define the current and future flood behaviour of the catchments, which includes the Lakes

and their tributaries - Millingandi Creek, Boggy Creek, Bald Hills Creek and Merimbula Creek.

The study is being prepared to meet the objectives of the NSW State Government's Flood Prone Land Policy and will establish the basis for subsequent floodplain management activities.

## Kianinny Jetty upgrade

Upgrades to the jetty at Kianinny Bay, Tathra are progressing well.

Favourable tides, seas and weather conditions have worked in Council's favour with the last concrete pour now complete.

The boat ramp lane nearest the jetty and the jetty itself are closed during the works, which should be completed by mid-September.

The jetty upgrade includes new concrete decks and berthing faces, and the removal of rock outcrops below the waterline that pose a fouling hazard to boats at low tide.

The project also includes the installation of ladders, mooring cleats, bollards and berthing fenders.

This project is being funded jointly by Bega Valley Shire Council and Roads and Maritime Services under the NSW Boating Now program and will cost \$115,000.
