Works update...

- Kerrisons Lane/ Tathra Road, Bega - Works are continuing with pavement rehabilitation and insitu stabilisation on Kerrisons Lane.
- Blackspot funding is enabling widening to take place at the intersection of Kerrisons Lane and Bega- Tathra road
- Various roadworks in Merimbula including the Merimbula Bypass, Palmer Street carpark and Market Street bridge approaches are continuing.
- Murrah Bridge works are continuing and aim to be complete by Christmas.
- Line marking has been carried out in key locations within the urban areas of Shire and will continue as required.
- Merimbula Pambula Cycleway- works are continuing in this area, with some excellent progress made.
- The newly formed Vegetation and Drainage teams are making excellent progress with grass cutting and mulching although there is still a mountain of work to do
- General maintenance and cleaning works are underway in all areas in preparation for the upcoming holiday season.
- Kerb and gutter works are beginning in Eden and Bermagui.

Pambula Beach viewing platform

The Pambula Beach viewing platform, damaged during destructive seas in June, has reopened in the last week with the addition of an access ramp and pathway.

People of all ages and abilities can now transition from the carpark to the platform, allowing them to have unsurpassed views across Pambula Beach to Merimbula and Haycock Point.

The job has been a collaboration between Pambula Beach Surf Club, Bega Valley Shire Council, Andrew Marshman & Assoc, SL SL Hodgson Builders and Coastal Builders NSW Pty Ltd. Well done and thank you to all involved!
