All abilities playground

After almost two years of fundraising and planning, the first sod has been turned in the upgrade to the playground at Merimbula's Ford Park. The existing play area will be given an exciting facelift and named Livvi's Place, making it the region's first playground that is inclusive and accessible for all people, including those with disabilities, in wheelchairs or with other mobility aids.



The upgrade has been a long term project for Bega Valley Shire Council, following consultation in 2012 that highlighted the need for more inclusive facilities in the Shire. Livvi's Place is the result of a unique partnership between a national charity, Touched by Olivia, the Rotary Club of Merimbula and Council. The Foundation helped to inform park design and assisted Council with raising funds to build the park. Council contributed about \$200,000 towards the cost of building the park and the Touched by Olivia Foundation raising about \$100,000 through working with corporate sponsors and local groups. A number of local community groups and organisations have been key supporters of the playground from the start, particularly the Rotary Club of Merimbula.

The tender for supply and installation of play equipment is underway, construction drawings and documents for landscape works are being finalised and will be put out for tender in the coming weeks. Construction on the upgrade to Ford Park playground is scheduled to commence in August-September 2015.

Coastal Zone plan on exhibition

Council has developed a Draft Coastal Zone Management Plan for Pambula Lake Estuary, a highly valued and scenic estuary. The plan identifies all the values and threats of Pambula Lake and suggests short, medium and long term actions for the estuaries management.

The aim is to have a long term strategic vision for the estuary and catchment, and to have achievable goals which can lead to the better estuary management and overall estuary health.

The draft plan will be on public exhibition until Tuesday 2 July and copies are available from the Bega Valley Shire Council head office, the four shire libraries and on our website. To comment on the plan go to www. begavalley.nsw.gov.au or you can post your submission to our Bega office.

Eden hotel DA refused

Council has rejected an application from the owner of the Hotel Australasia in Eden to amend his development application to allow staged development of the site.

Great Southern Developments Pty Ltd, applied to modify an earlier development consent that was issued by the Land and Environment Court of NSW for the demolition of the Hotel Australasia and construction of a retail development.

The modification sought approval to stage the works with Stage 1 being the demolition works and Stage 2 the construction and operation of the retail development.

Under the existing consent the applicant is required to pay the Section 94 car parking contribution of \$453,100 to Council prior to any work commencing.

The proposed staged modification would have resulted in the developer having no obligation to pay the Section 94 commitment prior to any demolition works commencing.

Mayor Michael Britten said the proposed staging was not in the public interest, and it posed a significant risk to the future growth of a town currently experiencing positive change through the Eden Port project and CBD improvements.
