Crofton Weed rust fungus

Council vegetation officers have been involved in the CSIRO release program of a new biological control agent for Crofton weed, the rust fungus. Crofton weed is a class 3 weed in the Bega Valley Shire which means the plant must be fully and continuously suppressed and destroyed. It establishes in areas along moist creeks and drainage beds under the shelter of trees, choking water flows and impeding on native vegetation. The weed is poisonous to horses, causing serious respiratory damage that can cause death. The rust fungus infects young leaves and stems and has great potential to reduce reproduction and spread of the weed. Infected weeds will be used to spread the rust to other problem areas in the Shire.
