Bega River flows to the sea again at Moogareeka

Bega Valley Shire Council opened the Bega River Mouth to the sea north of Tathra earlier this week.

Council has been carefully watching the rising river level in recent weeks, with live updates available every 15 minutes via a monitoring buoy at Mogareeka.

Mechanically opening the Bega River system starts to be a consideration when the river height reaches 1.26m, in line with guidelines from the NSW Office of Environment and Heritage. The approved opening height is 1.36m. That mark was reached on Tuesday.



A pilot channel was dug the next morning to take advantage of appropriate tidal conditions, that combined with the significant amount of water in the catchment, should result in a successful opening.

Council requests that members of the public keep well clear of these fast flowing and dangerous waters. This includes staying away from the sandbanks at the channel's edge as they can become unstable.

With the theme 'Let's do more **together'**, the festival promotes inclusive communities and provides an opportunity for seniors to try new things, contribute, and remain active and engaged in their local communities.

The NSW Seniors Festival is the largest festival for people over 60 in the Southern Hemisphere, attracting up to 500,000 seniors across the state to events and online.

Bega Valley Shire Council has provided grants to a number of organisations across the Shire to assist them in delivering these events. The festival will culminate on Thursday March 16th with the "Golden Gig Tea Party" which is being held at the Commemorative Civic Centre, Bega.

Formerly NSW Seniors Week, the NSW Seniors Festival has continued to grow each year since it began 59

years ago. It continues to set the benchmark as the biggest event program for seniors in the southern hemisphere.

In 2017 the festival will run for 10days from Friday 3 March to Sunday 12 March across NSW. During this annual festival there are a dozen or more events around NSW to inspire seniors to eat well, stay active and connect with their local community.

This NSW Seniors Festival, seniors will be inspired to try new things, socialise, share skills and keep doing the things they enjoy, together!
