Public assets vandalised

Vandals have torn up the grass by doing burnouts at the Roy Howard cricket field under the Bega bridge and at the Bega lookout over the weekend. Council's Bega town team discovered the deep gouges on Monday morning. To repair the damage the areas affected will have to be levelled out and topsoil imported to fill holes. In the case of the cricket field, returf or seed will be needed to bring it back to a good standard for sports people to play on and to enjoy recreation activities. If you see people damaging public assets anywhere in the Shire please report it to the police or Council rangers to take further action.
